

UHH-Email Access with Android Phone


This guide describes how to set up an Android Phone to access your UHH-Email account via the IMAP/SMTP protocol.

Summary of Server-Settings for Android


- **Account**
 - Email address: jane.doe@uni-hamburg.de
 - Username: B-code (format bae1234)
 - **Incoming server**
 - **IMAP** Server: exchange.uni-hamburg.de
 - Security type : SSL
 - Port: 993
 - **Outgoing server**
 - **SMTP** Server: exchange.uni-hamburg.de
 - Security type : TLS
 - Port: 587
 - **Notice:** Passwords with **German special characters** (ä, ö, ü, ß) will not be recognized by the UHH mail server via IMAP. You can change your UHH-password at the "Benutzerverwaltung" (bv.uni-hamburg.de).

We assume you have a standard Email-App installed on your Android phone. The **point-by-point description** below is tested for a Samsung Android Phone with a native email App and might deviate from your particular case. Essential are the settings above.


- Open your Email-App, go to the **Settings** and add a **new account**. It might look like this:




- If **IMAP** is not on the menu, select "Other" :



- Insert your UHH-Email-address and password and select "**Manual setup**":



- Choose "IMAP account":



- The username is your B-code:
